

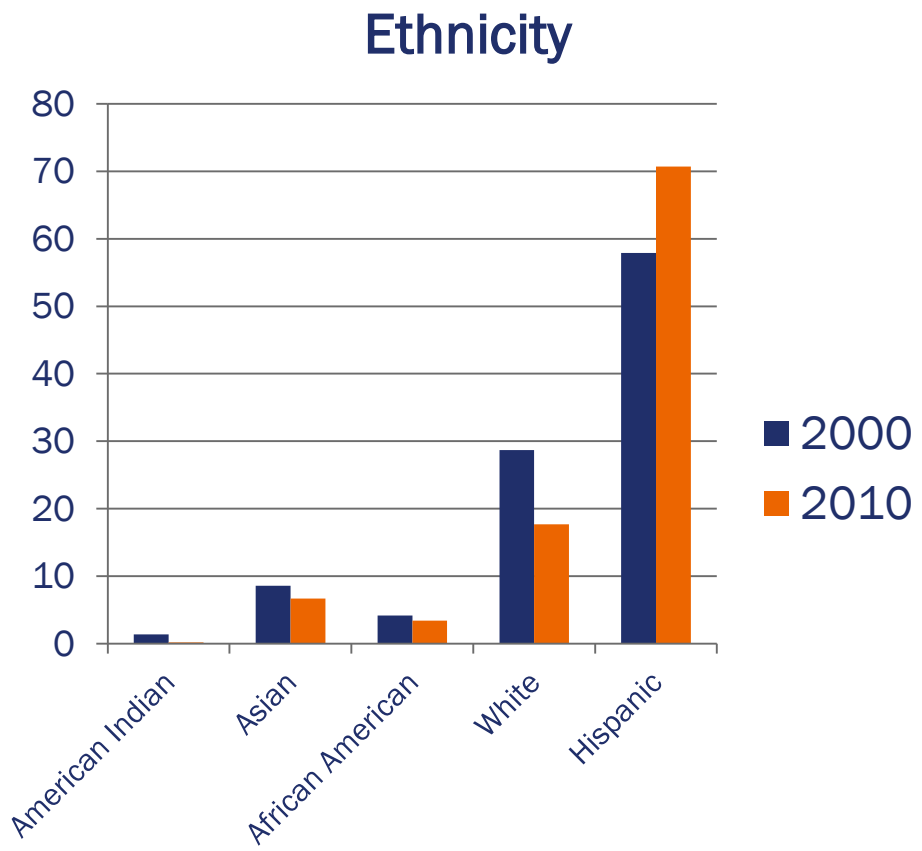
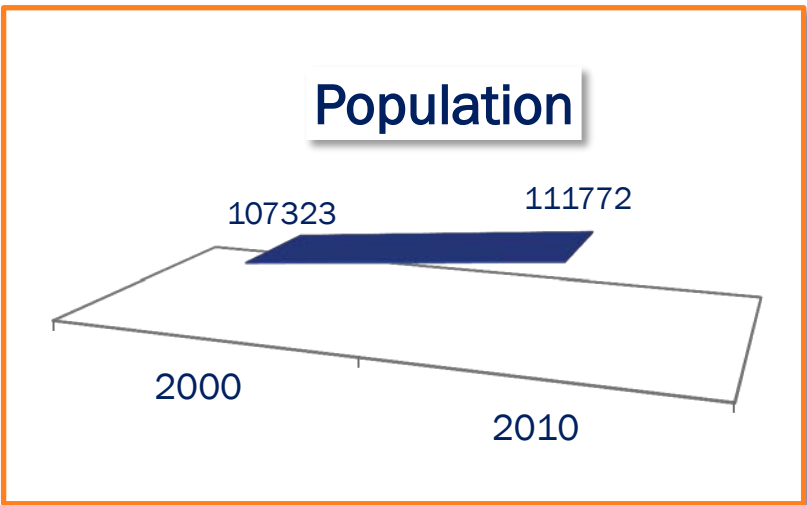

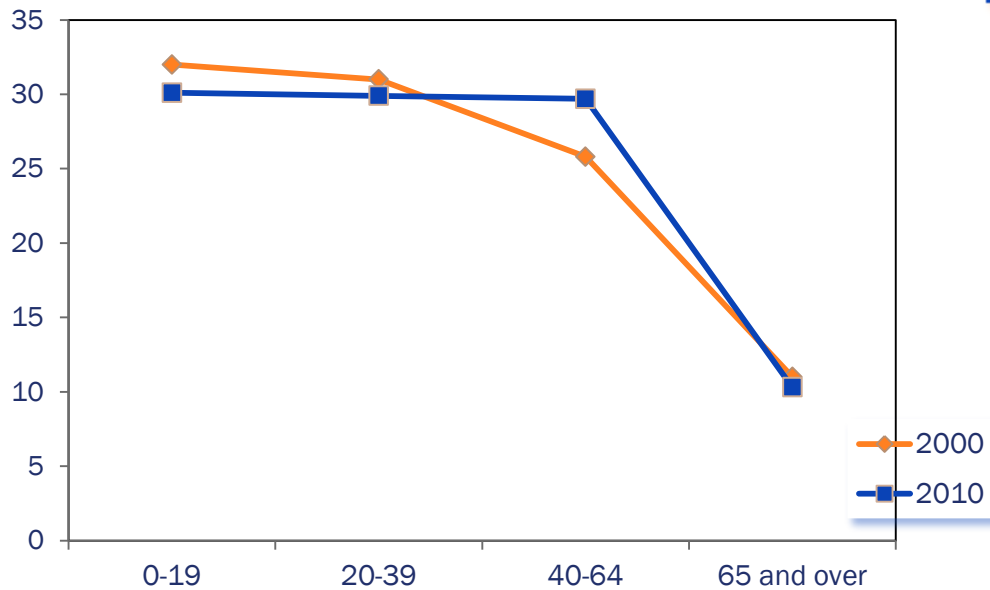

## Age Distribution

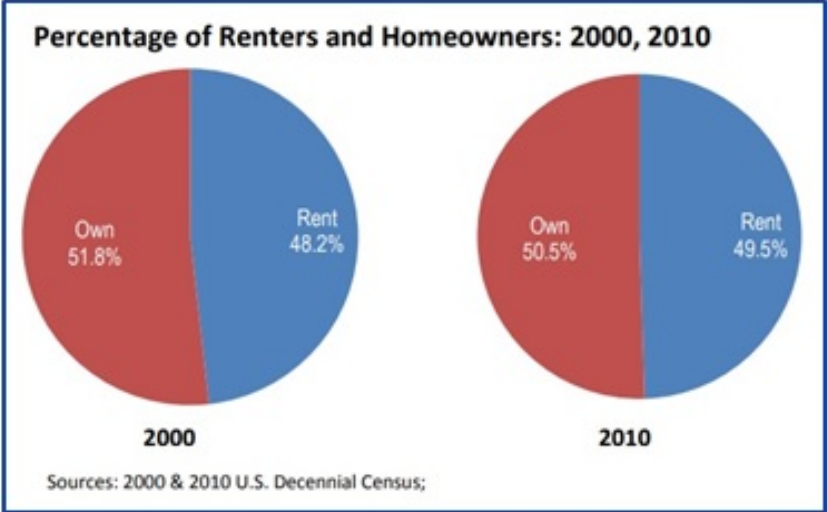

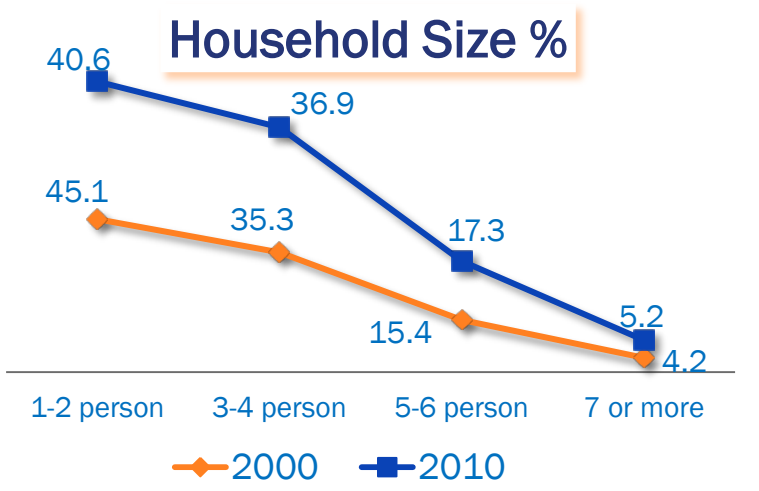

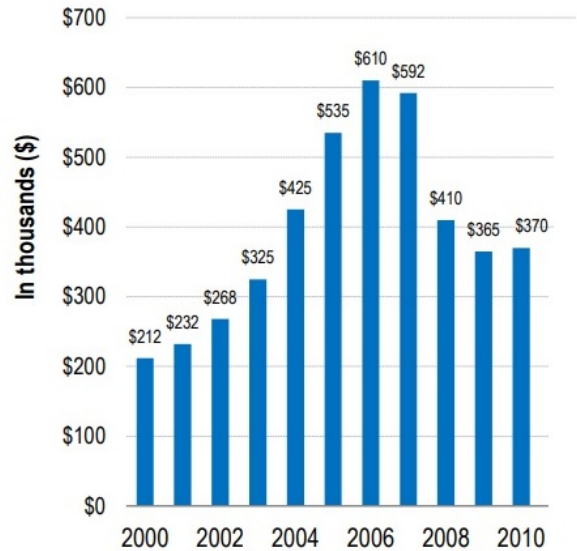

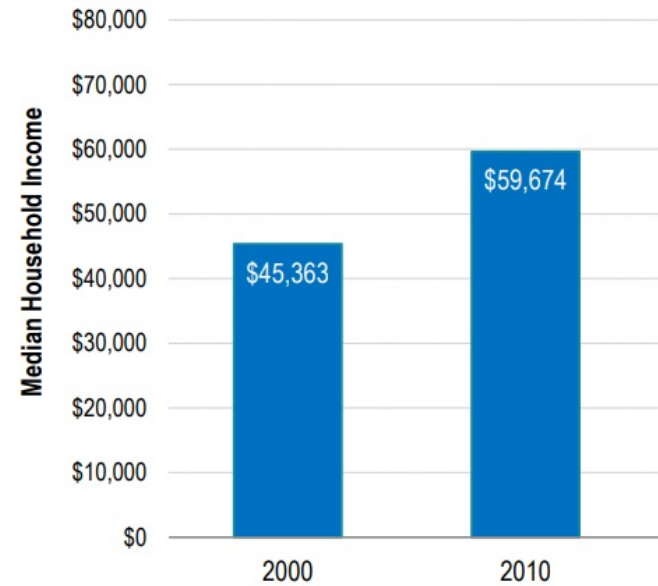
### Median Home Sales Price for Existing Homes: 2000 - 2010

### Median Household Income: 2000, 2010

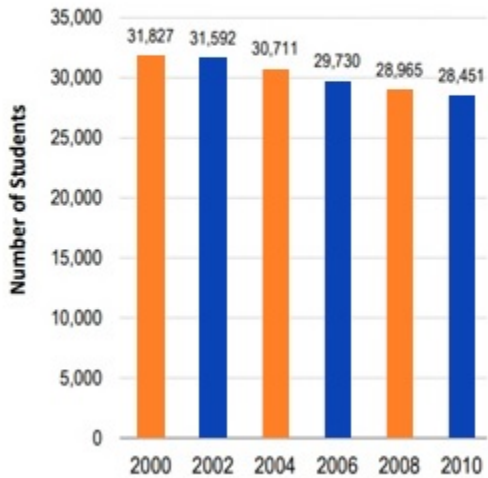

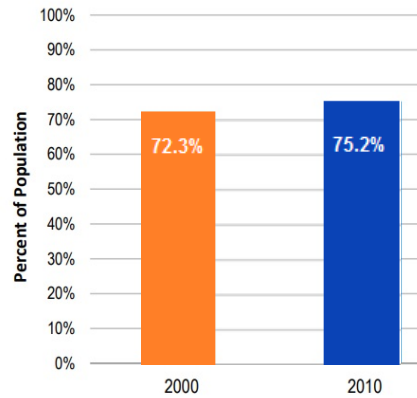
## Total Student Enrollment

### K-12 Public School Student Enrollment: 2000 - 2010



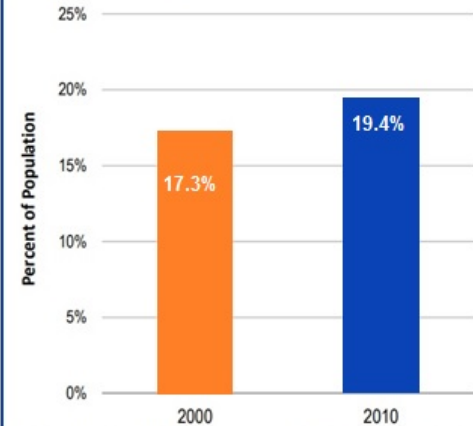

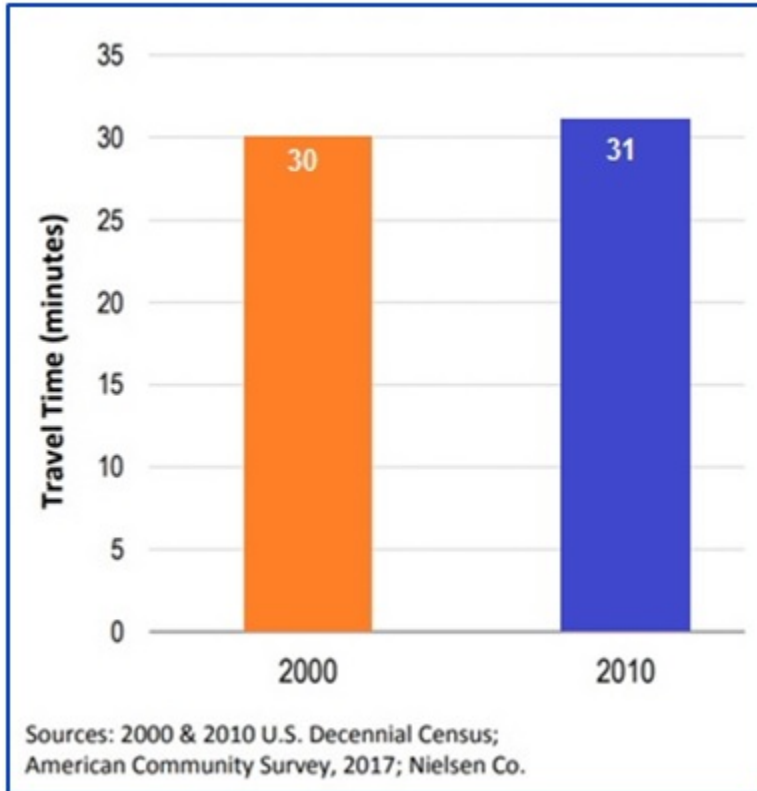
## Percent of City Population Completing a Bachelor's Degree or Higher



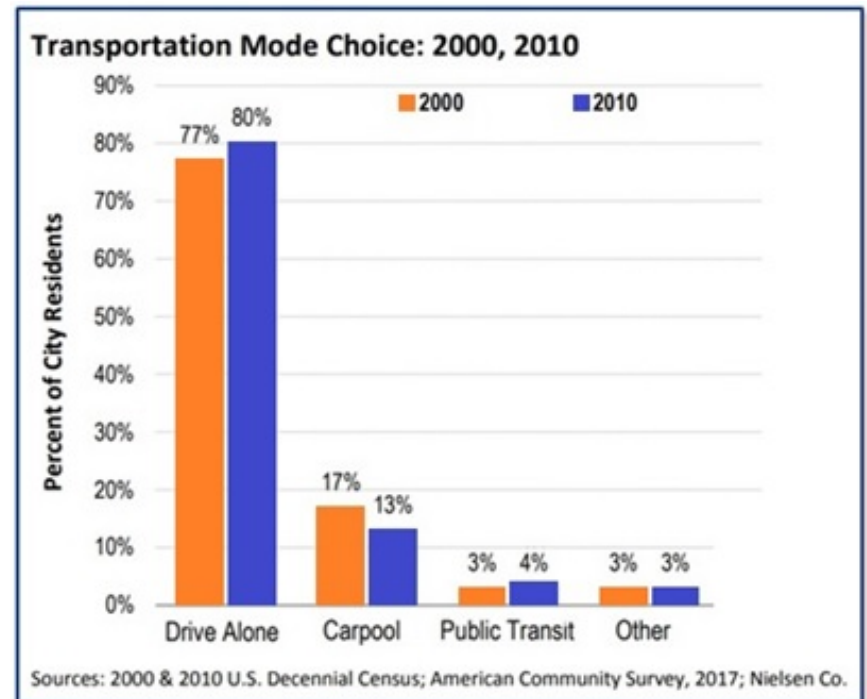

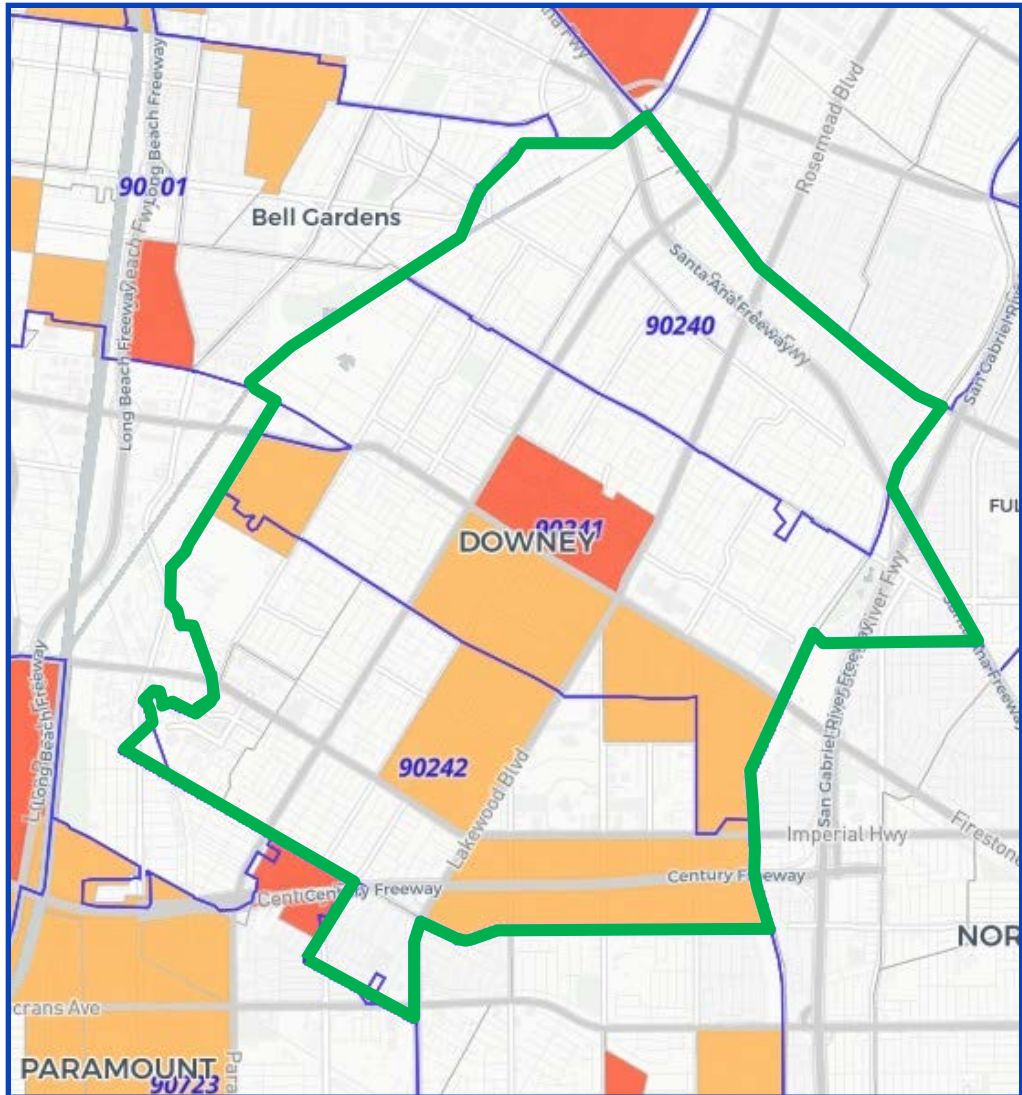
Average Travel Time to Work (minutes): 2000, 2010
