## **HOT WORK PERMIT**

This Hot Work Permit is required for any temporary operation involving open flames or producing heat and/or sparks. This includes, but is not limited to: brazing, cutting, grinding, soldering, thawing pipe, torch applied roofing, and welding.

**INSTRUCTIONS:** 1. Verify Required Precautions Checklist (Page 2) is completed prior to commencing work. If ALL ITEMS are not completed then HOT **WORK IS NOT TO BE CONDUCTED.** 2. Company performing the work is to complete the form and retain an APPROVED copy of the permit on the job site throughout the course of the work. ## REQUIRED PRECAUTIONS CHECKLIST

<u>GENERAL</u>
☐ Hot Work equipment in good repair
☐ Fire Alarm in-service
□ Nearest Fire Alarm Pull Station located at
□ Available sprinklers, hose streams, and extinguishers service / operable
□ Required Signage posted
□ Adequate shielding protection in public
☐ Adequate escape routes from area for workers / occupants
REQUIREMENTS WITHIN 35 FT. (11meters) OF WORK
☐ Flammable / Combustible liquids removed
□ Explosive atmosphere in area eliminated
☐ Floors swept clean of dust, lint, oily residue, ect.
☐ Combustible floors wet down, covered with damp sand or fire-resistive shielding
☐ Remove other combustibles where possible. Otherwise protect fire-resistant tarpaulins or metal shielding
☐ All wall and floor openings covered
☐ Fire resistant tarpaulins suspended beneath work
WORK ON WALLS AND/OR CELINGS
□ Construction is noncombustible and without combustible covering and/or insulation
☐ Combustibles on other side of walls moved away
WORK ON ENCLOSED EQUIPMENT
☐ Enclosed equipment cleaned of all combustibles
$\square$ Confined space requirement $\square$ YES $\square$ NO
☐ Containers purged of all flammable liquids / vapors
□ Pressurized vessels, piping and equipment removed from service, isolated, and vented
☐ Adequate ventilation
□ Asbestos and/or lead involvement
FIRE WATCH / HOT WORK MONITORING
☐ Fire watch will be provided during and for <u>30 minutes</u> after work, including any coffee or lunch breaks
☐ Fire watch is supplied with suitable extinguishers, and were practical, charged small hose
☐ Fire watch is trained in use of this equipment and in sounding alarm
☐ Fire watch may be required for adjoining areas above and below
☐ Monitor hot work area for 4 hours after job is competed
