## CITY OF DOWNEY TO OFFER COVID-19 EMERGENCY RESIDENTIAL RENTAL ASSISTANCE PROGRAM

## Downey, CA, June 16, 2020:

On **Wednesday**, **June 17**<sup>th</sup> **at 8 a.m.**, the City of Downey will launch the **COVID-19 Emergency Residential Rental Assistance Program**. The purpose of the program is to provide emergency rental assistance grants to income-eligible households who were economically impacted during the COVID-19 pandemic through job loss, furlough or reduction in hours or pay.

These grants will serve as rental payments made on behalf of an income-eligible household in an amount determined by the State of California, for a maximum period of 1 month to maintain housing and/or to reduce rental payment delinquency as a result of the economic downturn during the COVID-19 pandemic.

Rental payments will not be paid directly to households; rather, to the landlord or property management agent.

## **Application and Grant Distribution Process:**

Emergency Rental Assistance grants will be awarded to qualified applicants on a "first come, first served" basis until funds run out.

Residents can apply for the program starting on **Wednesday**, **June 17**<sup>th</sup> **at 8 a.m.** by calling **562-299-6706** to complete an intake form. Applications will only be accepted Monday through Friday from 8:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m.

If a household is considered eligible, an application will then be sent by email, mail, or may be retrieved in person from Downey City Hall.
