CA STATE ASSEMBLY BILL 1826

MANDATORY COMMERCIAL ORGANICS RECYCLING

Businesses and Multi-family Residential Dwellings **MUST HAVE** an organics recycling program in place by:

January 1, 2019

Generators of

4 or more cubic yards
of solid waste per week,
including trash, recycling,
and organics.

December 31, 2020

Generators of

2 or more cubic yards
of solid waste per week,
including trash, recycling,
and organics.

How to Comply

Subscribe to your local organics service or recycle all of your organic waste onsite or through a landscaping contractor.

Organics

Defined by the State as food waste, green waste, landscape and pruning waste, nonhazardous wood waste, and food-soiled paper waste that is mixed in with food waste.

Note: Multi-family residential dwellings are **NOT** required to recycle food waste at this time.

CA STATE ASSEMBLY BILL 341

MANDATORY COMMERCIAL RECYCLING

You are required to have recycling service if you are either:

A business that disposes of 4 or more cubic yards of solid waste per week.

OR

A multi-family dwelling of **5 units or more.**

How to Comply

Subscribe to your local recycling service or separate your recyclable materials from your trash and take them to a recycling center.
