- **Via laptop:** Click the “Raise Hand” button and wait to be unmuted
- **Via telephone:** Dial *9 on the phone keypad and wait to be unmuted

The meeting host will send an unmute request to the speaker in turn to unmute themselves

- **Via laptop:** Click the unmute button
- **Via telephone:** Dial *6 on the phone keypad to unmute the call

Speakers will wait in queue until it is their time to speak.
