SUBJECT: REVIEW OF THE RALPH M. BROWN ACT AND MEETING PROCEDURES

WITH THE PUBLIC WORKS COMMITTEE

RECOMMENDATION

Receive and file a presentation prepared and delivered by the City Attorney on the Ralph M. Brown Act and meeting procedures.

BACKGROUND

The Ralph M. Brown Act (Brown Act) was established to ensure that meetings of local governing bodies and commissions are being held in an open and transparent manner with the public. Requirements of the Brown Act include the need for a quorum to be present to hold the meeting, time set aside for public comments, the public right to attend meetings without identifying themselves, all votes being cast publicly, and materials being made available to the members of the public. Agendas for the regular meetings must be posted 72 hours prior to the meeting.

DISCUSSION

The Public Works Committee has several new members that have been appointed and staff is providing an opportunity to review the Ralph M. Brown Act. The City Attorney will be providing an educational overview of the Brown Act and will also review meeting procedures with the Public Works Committee.
