

Temporary Sign Standards

The use of temporary signs are regulated by Municipal Code Section 9618.06. Below is a summary of the development standards for temporary signs. Failure to comply with Municipal Code Section 9618.06 may result in issuance of an administrative citation and/or other legal action.

Banners

- Maximum size is limited to thirty-two (32) square feet.
- Banners shall only be mounted to the wall of the building and shall not be affixed to a fence, vehicle, tree, ground, pole, etc.
- Banners shall not be higher than the roof line.
- Only one (1) banner may be displayed on an elevation with a maximum of two (2) banners may be displayed at any time.




Streamers

- Shall not encroach on or above the public right-of-way nor be attached to public utility poles.
- Shall not interfere with vehicular traffic visibility.
- Shall not be displayed on or within any vehicles.



Temporary Window Signs

- Temporary window signs shall not to exceed thirty (30) percent in any one window
- Any portion of a sign located within thirty-six (36) inches of a window will be considered a window sign.
- Temporary window signs and permanent window signs may not be simultaneously displayed on the same window



Balloons and Inflatables

- Maximum height of balloon/inflatable shall not to exceed forty (40) feet.
- Height of roof mounted balloon/inflatable shall not to exceed seventyfive (75) feet above adjacent grade.
- Flying height of tethered balloon/inflatable shall not to exceed one hundred twenty-five (125) feet above adjacent grade
- Illumination of balloon/inflatable is permitted except for moving or flashing lights.
- Placement of balloon shall not obstruct vehicular traffic visibility.
- Maximum of one (1) balloon/inflatable may be displayed at any time.
- Size of tethered balloon/inflatable shall not exceed three hundred (300) cubic feet.
- A red or white beacon light must be mounted on the highest point of the tethered balloon/inflatable. The beacon light must be
 activated from sundown to sunrise.

Searchlights and Lasers

- Shall not be placed within one hundred (100) feet of a residential zone.
- Shall be operated only from sunset to midnight.
- Prior to the approval of a permit involving a laser, the applicant must provide evidence to the Planning Division of issuance of a Food and Drug Administration (FDA) "Variance" and a Federal Aviation Administration (FAA) "Letter of Non-objection."
