



Smoke and Carbon Monoxide Alarm Self-Certification

This self-certification is to be filled out by the permittee, property owner, or authorized HOA representative of the property referenced below and given to the building inspector at final inspection.

California Residential Code (CRC), section 314 requires smoke and carbon monoxide alarms to be installed in residential buildings when alterations, additions, or repairs requiring a permit occur.

I, the undersigned, hereby certify that I am the owner, contractor, or authorized HOA representative of the above referenced property. I further certify that smoke detectors and carbon monoxide alarms are present and functional in all the locations marked below.

All boxes below must be checked:

- Smoke Alarms and Carbon Monoxide Alarm:** On the ceiling or wall outside of each separate sleeping area in the immediate vicinity of bedrooms or in each hallway outside of the rooms.
- Smoke Alarms:** In each room used for sleeping purposes.
- Smoke Alarms and Carbon Monoxide Alarm:** In each story, including any habitable basement. (Note: In dwellings or dwelling units with split levels and without an intervening door between the adjacent levels, a smoke alarm and a carbon monoxide detector installed on the upper level shall suffice for the adjacent lower level provided that the lower level is less than one full story below the upper level.)

Retrofitted detectors may be battery operated for buildings where no alternations are performed on the interior. Multiple-purpose alarms (carbon monoxide and smoke alarms) shall comply with all applicable standards and must be approved by the State Fire Marshall. The devices must be installed per manufacturer’s specifications.

NOTE: These requirements only apply to the dwelling unit(s) for which the permit applies. For example, if an apartment building roof is replaced all the units within the building would be required to be retrofitted/verified to have the detectors and alarms. For an interior remodel of a single unit, only that unit would be required to be retrofitted/verified.

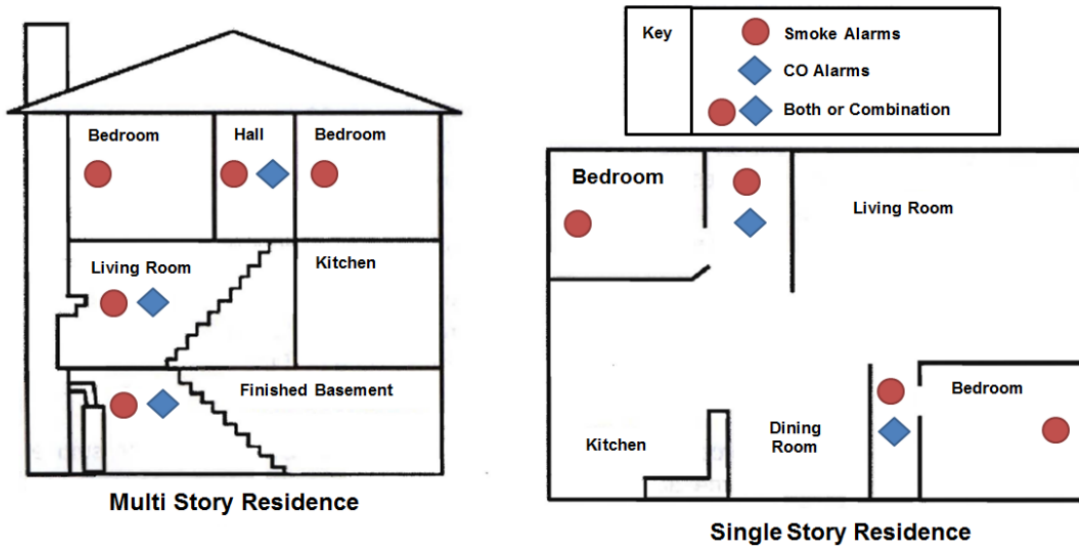
